Community Based Health Centers:

Member clinics of the Community Health Partnership

ROLE: Organizing host of mobile mammography screening events

- Attend all CMAP orientations and trainings for policy and procedures
- Conduct primary intake to determine eligibility
- Register, schedule, and make reminder calls/letters for patients (meeting eligibility requirements)
- Staffing of CMAP events
- Track/document all follow ups and missed appointments.
- Identify core site team including four primary contacts 1. CMAP Care Coordinator, 2. Medical Liaison 3. Outreach/Health Educator 4. Media Relations/Primary Decision Maker

CMAP Advisory Committee

A standing committee of the Women's Health Partnership

ROLE: Guide, monitor and advance the present and future agenda of CMAP

- Offer input and support on the CMAP goals, objectives, and activities.
- Advise on project planning, fund development, implementation and evaluation.
- Identify new community resources and share with partners

The Community Health Partnership:

Under the Leadership of the Women's Health Partnership: The Community Mammography Access Project (CMAP)

ROLE: Facilitating agency of a mobile breast health screening and referral service

- Oversee all aspects of the CMAP operations between partners
- Convene regular CMAP advisory meetings
- Data collection for ongoing program evaluation and quality assessment
- Connect with tumor registry to support data collection/reporting efforts of CMAP

Santa Clara Valley Health & Hospital Systems (SCVHHS):

Under the Department of Diagnostic Imaging at Valley Medical Center (VMC)

ROLE: Interpreting radiology group

- Process VMC MR # for all new patients scheduled for CMAP event
- Provide equipment and technical assistance for film processing
- Film interpretation, reporting, and storing
- Schedule all referrals for diagnostic exams and report outcomes to clinics (including missed and kept appointments)
- Provide secondary quality check regarding financial eligibility
- Provide radiologist liaison

Inner Images, Inc:

Mobile mammography program

ROLE: Provide equipment and personnel for delivery of mammography screening services for participating clinics

- Provide screenings for all confirmed CMAP events scheduled on master calendar for 2007
- Meet all MQSA standards
- Process all films within 8-12 hours of CMAP events at SCVHHS
- Follow SCVHHS protocol for all film requirements
- Adhere to the highest clinical, technical and service delivery standards for patient centered care
