






Ethnicity



Priority Areas and 2018 Key Activities



Preventing Heart Attacks and Strokes Every Day Evidence based population health program implemented in CHCs designed to reduce heart attacks and strokes for patients at risk of cardiovascular disease.

Patient Care Access Program

Developed to expand access to the remaining uninsured in Santa Clara County who are not eligible for MediCal.

Patient Centered Communication

Train-the-trainer workshops given to clinic leadership in this patient centered approach to communication and treatment using the CI CARE model.

Civic Engagement Academy

Six-week workshop series created to inform CHC staff and consumer board members on history of CHCs, legislative process, communication skills, and problem solving.
